If a member is not able to, or does not wish to, attend a particular screening they are permitted to give their membership card to a non-member who may attend in their place. Membership cards will be issued after the membership fee has been paid, at the first screening a member attends.

There will be no ticket sales at the door!

If a member wishes to bring a guest to a screening they may do so provided they phone the contact person for their venue to make sure there are seats available. Visitors may only attend one screening free, after that they will be required to join the SFFS to attend further screenings.
